*** V3 - Past participle





Present Perfect Examples:

· I have never been to France.

· I have bought a book today

· Has he ever been in China?






Signal words

Already yet ever never just before





already

- Already means that something happened earlier than we expected.
- With Present Perfect <u>already</u> usually goes after <u>have or has</u> and <u>before the main</u> verb or at the end of the sentence



already

- Our neighbours <u>have</u> already <u>cut</u> the old tree.
- · She has already read this book.

I have been to Tokyo already



Yet

- Yet means that something that we expected has happened or hasn't happened.
- Yet is used in negative statements and questions
- We usually put yet at the end of a sentence.



Yet

· Has he arrived yet?

· They haven't eaten yet.

· Have you met Judy yet?





Ever & never

- The adverbs ever and never express the idea of an unidentified time before now
- I have never visited Germany 'Ever' is used
- 1) in questions.

Have you ever been to England?

- · 2) in negative questions
- · Haven't you ever eaten Chinese food?



Ever & never

BE CAREFUL!

- You must not use never and not together:
- · I haven't never been to Italy.
- · I have never been to Italy.





Just

 We use JUST to talk about actions that happened resently.

Dan and Kelly <u>have</u> just <u>had</u> a baby girl" (it means the baby was born a few days ago)



Before

 We use before to talk about actions that happened some times ago but nobody know when actually

· I have seen it before.
